

Gillespie Show Horses

2010 Training Price Sheet

Full Board/Training: \$800/month

*Multiple horse discount of \$100 per horse

This includes heated stall, feeding w/ supplements, turnout, blanketing, grooming, clipping, and a minimum of 5 rides per week. Lessons are unlimited in this price.

Full Board: \$400/month

This includes everything listed above except for riding and clipping. If you wish to receive lessons while your horse is on board, it will be \$50 per lesson.

Supplements/Vitamins:

If you request or your horse requires special supplements, we will gladly feed these for you. Customer will be responsible for the cost of and/or providing any additional supplements.

Hauling: \$0.65/mile up to 1000 miles, .50/mile for trips over 1000 miles, minimum of \$50.00 local hauling.

*Multiple horse discount, additional horses will be \$0.25/mile, minimum \$25.00

Day Fees: \$40/day for each day away from home including travel days.

This covers traditional show day fees, including meals, additional hired help, and all the extra labor associated with being at the show-stall set up, show grooming, supplies, and preparation, etc...multiple horse discounts and discounts for horses which are not showing (ie: two year olds at the show for experience) will apply.

Banding/Braiding: \$30 Bands/\$50 Braids

At large shows and when possible, we may hire a 3rd party to band/braid...charges may vary.

Farrier/Chiropractor/Dentist: Charges will vary according to horse needs and special circumstances.

Veterinarian: Vet services will be charged directly to you.

Winnings: Open winnings will be split 50/50 after the entry fee when we exhibit the horse.

Sheets/Blankets/Slinkies: Each horse that will be showing is requested to have their own set of "show clothes". This includes a black winter blanket, black sheet, black slinky, and black or white mesh summer slinky. We prefer to use Schneiders sheets and blankets. www.sstack.com We are able to provide turnout/barn sheets, hoods, and blankets, as well as leg wraps, polos, good halters for shows, etc. Please contact us to get these ordered for your horse as needed.

Invoices: Payment will be due within 15 days of invoice, a \$25 late charge will apply for late invoices up to 30 days with a 5% late fee per month on outstanding balances. d horses with an outstanding balance may not be taken to horse shows.
